SINOPSYS

Party Time is a show that invites us to venture out into the world of parenthood, and more generally, that of care. Just as the famous Geppetto discovered what it means to become a dad thanks to his puppet, the clown Bergamotto shares his every day experiences with his adorable little teddy bear, with whom he will live many exciting adventures.

Party Time is a story that shares many cherished moments in the life of Bergamotto's family, moments packed with good excuses to celebrate life! Pasquale Marino, creator and performer of this show says that being a father is an explosion of emotions and that this extravagant and exciting show is the perfect way for a clown to share such an experience.

Party Time is Bergamotto's company new creation, a company with more than ten years of experience researching and developing the language and poetry of contemporary clowning. A theatrical invitation that moves between moments of tenderness and absurdity through the non-verbal language of mime.

Age recommendation: 3-8 and family audiences **Techniques used:** A visual story without words, a clown show, pantomime and live music, for an audience of any age.

Party Time, the extraordinary adventures of a one-of-a-kind father, is an original story that explores different aspects of what it means to be a father: birth, protection, fear, celebration...

A simple comedy and small production. A day with dad.

Once upon a time there was a dad who loved the circus, who loved to play and do acrobatics with his teddy bear.

A genuine and accesible show for everyone to enjoy just like a birthday cake. Beyond the theme of paternity there is that one of what it means caring for others. A show as appetising as a birthday cake that deals with the topic of fatherhood, and more generally what it means to care for others.

A little simple comedy. A day with dad.

The pace of the story is fast, the gestural language is simple and ironic. The songs and the use of a small accordion make it very appealing, inviting the audience to constantly participate.

A fun and comforting show that is like a tongue twister sharing all of those experiences that are lived in the first years of a baby's life: creating habits and customs, the small misunderstandings, the joys, the fears that all parents experience...

The play culminates with the big birthday party for Giacomino the teddy bear's first year, which the audience attends and participates in.

AUTHOR - PASQUALE MARINO

Being a father is an explosion of emotions that I want to tell in this extravagant and exciting story.

I have recently become a father, a wonderful experience that I want to share with this new show. In recent years, I have specially felt the need to tell a story about of what really anchors us to life and allows us to have confidence in the future, in the new generations.

On stage there is me, Bergamotto, and a teddy bear, my son Giacomino; and together, we will share all those little moments and details that being a father has allowed me to discover: singing a song to make him fall asleep, playing with him, organising a birthday party and much more...The show tells the story of "being a dad" with minimal props and stage set: a clown, who not only

provokes laughter, but is also very moving thanks to his capacity to show some of the fears and vulnerabilities that parents experience daily. The framework of the work chooses simplicity: there is no large sets and props but it is the body and voice that interacts with the audience.

If I only manage to share a tenth of the emotions and sensations that I have experienced in the last few I would be deeply satisfied with this new exciting project.

Degree in Developmental and Educational Psychology, Postgraduate in "Theatre for groups with functional diversity" University of Rome and Postgraduate in "Theatre and Education" at Institute of Theatre in Barcelona.

Arts France and was elected Administrator in 2009 and delegate at Circus Arts in SACD in 2015.
